
## **HOW TO APPLY TO ERASMUS+ MOBILITY IN NEPTUN**


With this few steps I would like to show you how to apply to Erasmus+ mobility in one or our partner universites.



# 2nd Step

You have to choose the right academic year you'd like to apply to (it is always the following academic year to the one we are in in the time of application). You have to click on the + sign at the end of the line, where you will have three options. As I don't have access to the English platform of Neptun, the names I write here might not be the correct one, but you'll get the idea:


- Apply for studies
- Apply for placement
- Apply for studies and placement



# **3rd Step**


Now that you chose the type of mobility, you have to choose the University. Please look through the list, and once you find the one you'd like, just click on the + sign and then 'Apply'

Please note, that you can see those universities ONLY, that offers the same subject area as yours. Some have primary or pre-school education only, but some have both. If you cannot see a university, that means you cannot apply to that.




Once you clicked on 'Apply' you have to see the platform below. Here you have to choose your subject are, the coordinator (it doesn't matter who you choose), the planned starting date (it is usually the 1st September or 1st February) and finally, you have to give the planned duration which can be between 3-5 months for studies.

If you are finished, just click on the 'Apply' button on the bottom of the page.




Now comes some information and statements. Here you have to state whether you've been an Erasmus student before or not, if you were, then when.

Once it is complete, just click on the button below (hand in request)




That's one part of the application done. Please close this little window here and then you'll be able to upload the necessary application documents.

### What we require:

- CV;
- Motivation letter;
- Language certificate;
- certificate of your gardes in the previous semester(s);
- certificate of participation in Student Union activities or others at related organizations (if relevant);
- certificate of participation in a Student Mentor/Buddy System, supporting students (if relevant)



And there you go, you completed your application. Please note, that you have to do this again, if you would like to apply to more universities. With one round you can do only on application!

#### And remember! Minimum 1, but maximum 3 Universities!

You can find your applications by clickin Administration/Erasmus/Application. Choose the year and there they will be.
