

How to generate a password to your Neptun system

First, please visit the [website qlter.elte.hu](http://www.qlter.elte.hu), switch the language to English.

- Then, on the left side you can see the log in platform (withing the red square), please click 'New password'.

- Click next, and you'll find yourself on this page where you have to fill the required parts:

That is as far as the system allowed me to go with the page, but after this I think you only have to give your date of birth (I suggest it to write the following way: year/month/day) and then you will end up on the page where you can generate the new password.

- On the top you'll find the 'Student web' that will lead you directly to your own platform




