COURSES FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Our faculty offers a wide selection of courses in **primary and pre-school education** in English and German languages. For example

We require students to already choose courses in their application form before the Learning Agreement is finalized to eliminate further changes.

PLACEMENT

Our faculty offers placement in limited numbers in one of our partner schools and kindergartens. Students have the opportunity to try themselves in a native or bilingual environment either in English or German with the following conditions.

STUDENTS' UNION

Our faculty offers a buddy/mentor to each exchange student to support them in their studies and also in everyday matters that might occur.

The union also responsible for different activities in the faculty organized for both Hungarian and international students.

They are part of the ELTE ESN system.



STUDENT HOUSING

Our university offers accommodation in its student residence halls.

Though these are mainly for degree students we encourage Erasmus students to apply as well.

In case of private accommodation our university has verified partners who help students finding the most suitable appartements around the city.

This is mediated by the university's Housing Office.



COST OF LIVING AND CURRENCY

Hungary uses **forint (HUF)** as its currency, but some places it is available to pay in euros (\in).

The accommodation cost in Hungary can differ from district to district. Living alone can cost somewhere between 140.000-250.000 HUF/month (around 350 – $650 \in$).

Our faculty currently has 56 Erasmus+ Agreements in 22 countries in Europe. These agreements consist of student and staff mobility exchanges, and are open for application in every academic year.
