### **MODULE AIMS:**

The aim of the course is to develop students' methodological and language competencies necessary for music education in bilingual preschool settings. Students will get a detailed picture of the educational aims of music education at pre-school level, the management and the practice of teaching. They will explore how to promote young learners' language development effectively through working in a bilingual environment. They will start to develop their own professional theories of teaching by reflecting on the observed activities.

### **MODULE SUBJECT:**

In this course, the following topics are covered: giving instructions, using activities and games, structuring and planning bilingual kindergarten music sessions. The course work involves presentations of theoretical and practical themes, microteaching, and reflecting on observations.

The course develops competences and provides the students with a language base through the following topics: 1. Children's songs, nursery rhymes 2. Folksongs and folkdance rhymes 3. Unison songs with more complicated rhythm. 4. Using scales and intervals during music sessions.
