

On the eastern side of Poland, the city of Bialystok is accepting primary and pre-school education students of TÓK to its English-speaking courses.

Two students can apply annually to exchange mobility.

Semesters start at the beginning of October and February; both semesters are available for application.

Accommodation:

The university offers places in halls of residences, you can find information <u>here</u>. In case you don't want to use this opportunity, you need to indicate it when doing the registration process in the university's <u>IKR system</u>.

Travel:

There is no direct plane route to Bialystok. According to the university's website, the advised route is to travel to Warsaw's Chopin or Modlin airport. Both are around 200 km away from Bialystok where you can travel by bus or train from Warsaw.
