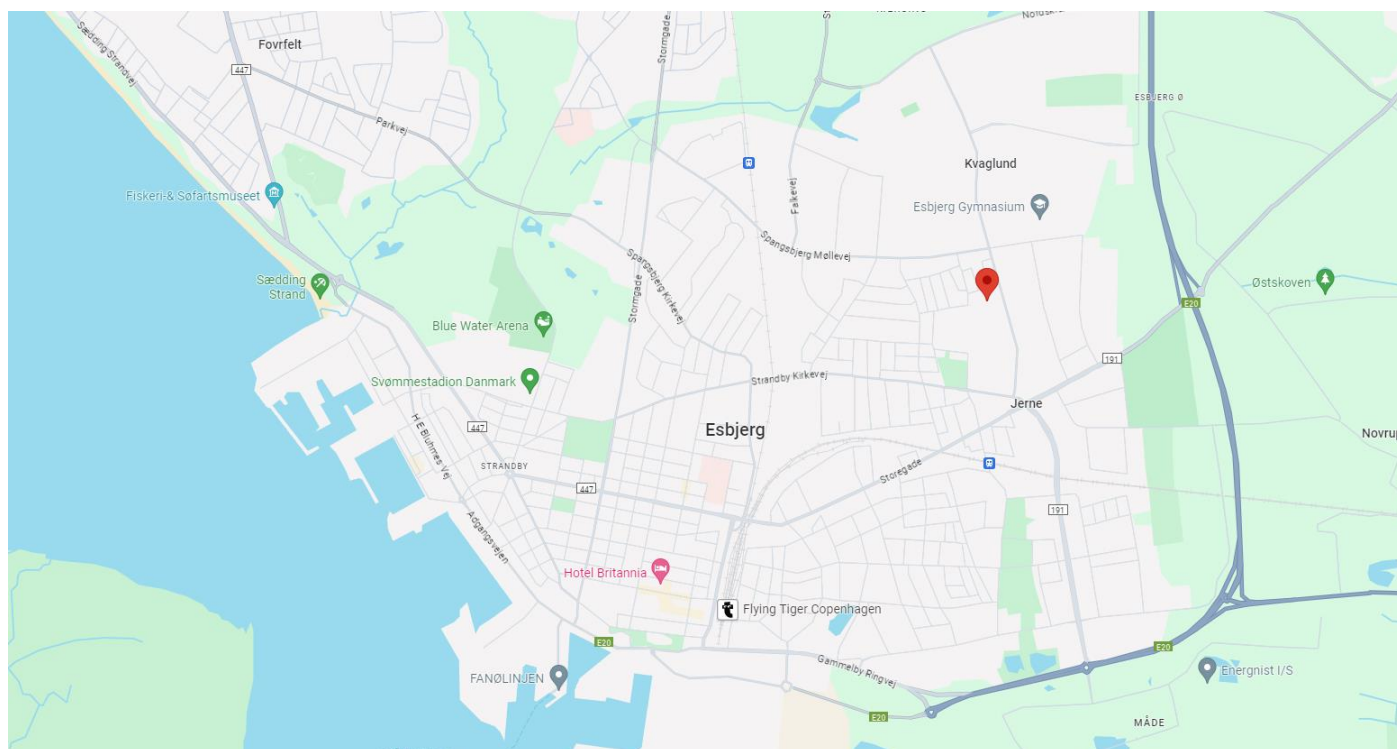

Semesters start in mid-August and at the beginning of February; both semesters are available for application.
