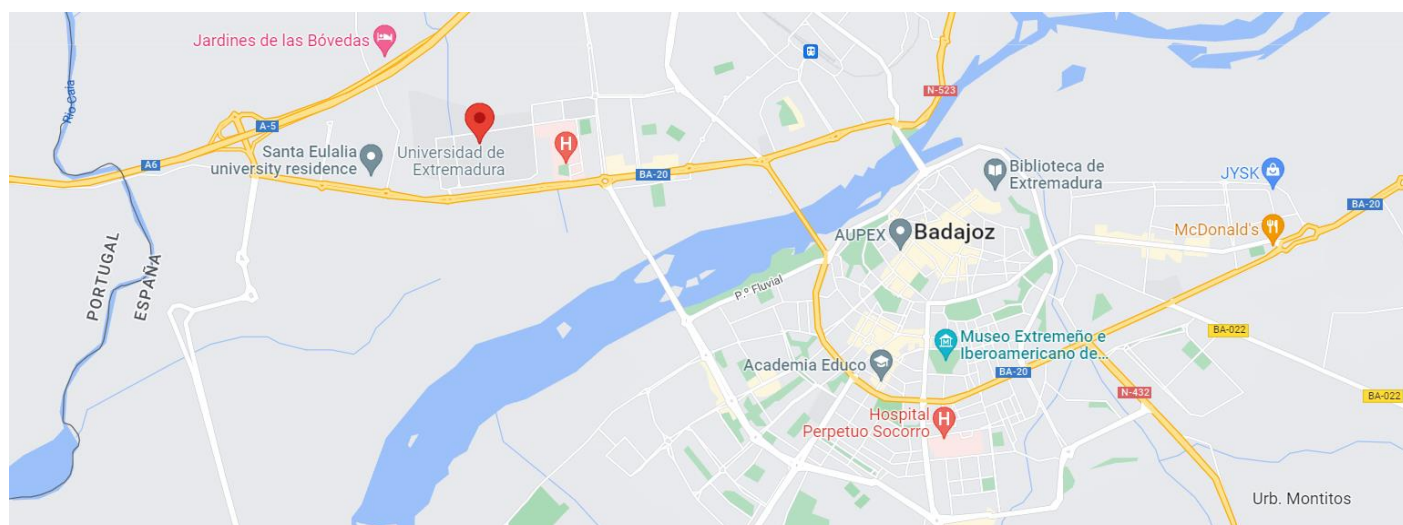

Close to the border of Portugal, the city of Badajoz is accepting primary and pre-school education students of ELTE TÓK for its English- and Spanish-speaking courses.

Two students can apply annually to exchange mobility.

Semesters start in September and at the beginning of February; both semesters are available for application.

Accommodation:

The university does not own any residence halls. There are other residence halls in the city that belong to other universities; in case the student is interested in staying in these they need to make contact themselves.
