

BIP – Salamanca, Spain – 11-15 May 2026



From May 11–15 our Faculty participated in a BIP Erasmus+ mobility program hosted by Universidad Pontificia de Salamanca in Salamanca, Spain. The program focused primarily on primary education and explored innovative approaches to teaching and learning through multimodality, STEAM education, and emerging technologies. It provided an enriching international academic experience, characterized by a warm welcome and continuous support from the professors and organizers.

One of the most valuable aspects of the program was the opportunity to collaborate in multicultural groups with participants from Spain, Romania, Finland, Italy, Hungary, and Crete.

The academic program was focused on workshops and interactive sessions. We explored different modes of communication, self-expression and meaning-making. We were also introduced to psychological background related to individual educational needs. Another important component of the mobility was the integration of emerging technologies and artificial intelligence into education.

In addition to theoretical sessions, we participated in several practical and experiential activities, including science experiments - herbarium projects, and workshops exploring the presence of mathematics in everyday life through urban art and public spaces.

The learning processes and workshops throughout the week culminated in a final group project, where participants focused on a chosen educational topic with STEAM and multimodal approaches.

Beyond the academic activities, the mobility also offered cultural enrichment through guided city tours and historical guidance about Salamanca. We learned about the city’s outstanding academic heritage and its significance as home to the first university in Spain, founded in 1218. Salamanca combines a rich historical and cultural background with a calm and welcoming atmosphere, making it an ideal environment for higher education and student life.
