Admissions procedure for foreign citizens / Hungarian citizens with foreign high school certificates or double citizenship holder

If you are a foreign citizen or a Hungarian citizen with double citizenship and have obtained your high school diploma in an international school in Hungary or in any foreign school abroad, you can apply through the DreamApply system of ELTE as an international self-funded applicant.

1. Read the program description

2. Read details under "Admissions"

Carefully read the details about admission requirements, application procedures, and the procedure of the entrance examination for the selected programme under "Admissions" in the programme description. It is also advisable to check all deadlines and fees carefully.

3. Start your application in the online application system

Register in the online application system. Fill in the online application form and upload the required documents.

- Bachelor-level degree;
- CV;
- Motivation letter*;
- Letter of recommendation**;
- Copy of the main pages of the passport scanned, in colour all personal details and expiry date must be shown, the passport must be valid;
- Proof of the Application fee and the Entrance exam fee transfer;
- Language certificate

***The general guidelines and expectations for the letter are:**

Please, explain why you would like to study in Hungary and how you are related to Central European culture. Specify your studies to date and to what extent the following fields have been included in your studies so far: communication, psychology, mediation, leadership studies, arts, minority groups and conflict management. The length of the motivation letter is between 1000 and 2000 words.

****Letter(s) of recommendation OR reference(s)**

Number of recommendations to submit: 2

We will only accept references from university lecturers with a Ph.D. degree who have in-depth knowledge on cultural studies and have an understanding of Central European culture.

Step-by-step Guide:

Step 1: entrance examination fee	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> After accepting the data processing notices, please select the faculty/organizational unit ("Faculty (organizational unit)" field) to which you are applying. In our case it is the Faculty of Primary and Pre-School Education In the "Payment title" field, select the "entrance examination fee" option. In the "Subtitle" field, select the "MA/MSc (foreign)" option. Leave the number of items field set to "1"! The entrance exam fee is EUR 50, and this amount will automatically appear on the screen with these settings. Add the selected prize to your cart, then add the next item.
Step 2: application fee	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Select the faculty/organizational unit ("Faculty (organizational unit)" field) to which you are applying. In our case it is the Faculty of Primary and Pre-School Education In the "Payment title" field, select the "application fee" option. In the "Subtitle" field, select the "MA/MSc (foreign)" option. Leave the number "1" in the Number of Items field! The entrance exam fee is EUR 150, and this amount will automatically appear on the screen with these settings Add the selected prize to your cart, then click next. Pay the amount by following the additional steps required on the interface. You will receive an invoice for the payment to the email address provided on the interface. Attach this to your application form.

5. Submit your application online

When you have prepared your application, don't forget to click on the "submit" button to submit your application.

6. Take the online entrance examination

After you submit the application, you will receive information about the online 30-minute entrance exam from the coordinator of the Faculty of Primary and Pre-School Education. [Learn more about the interview here.](#)

7. Letter of Acceptance and tuition fee

If you do not meet the requirements, you will be notified of the rejection of your application. If you meet the requirements and have completed a successful exam, you will receive the document '*Letter of Acceptance*' in the online application system.

You will also receive more information about how to pay the tuition fee and all the to-do's that you need to arrange before you arrive at ELTE, Faculty of Primary and Pre-School Education in Budapest.

8. Accept the offer your application

After you receive your 'Letter of Acceptance', please confirm your intent to enrol in the online application system.
